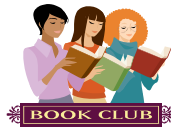

Newcomers Selected Charities for 2021-2022

Each August, our Newcomers Board and our President select the charitable and service organizations that we will be working to help support during the year. Also, at every monthly Coffee and Luncheon, a Purple Bucket will be passed for your voluntary contribution to a registered charity that the Board has selected for that month.

<u>President's Pick:</u>	<i>Neighbor-To-Neighbor.</i> Their mission “is to connect volunteers, community professionals, and funders in designing, developing, and implementing programs that impact the independent living needs of our adult community.” They provide volunteer transportation to medical appointments, grocery shopping, pharmacy visits and other errands, social service appointments, barber/beauty shop appointments, and other life sustaining or life-enhancing appointments or events. They are designed to help our neighbor who is home-bound due to age, disability, and or chronic illness in Horry and Georgetown Counties.
<u>Board Pick:</u>	<i>Rape Crisis Center Serving Horry and Georgetown Counties.</i> Their mission “is to provide services to survivors and victims of rape.” They provide support and services to victims of sexual assault; promote and encourage the prevention of sexual assault. They attend the ER with the victim, and after discharge, provide counseling and connect the victims with local agencies that can help them. They provide meds at no cost. Volunteers are always needed.....You will all be hearing lots more about these two organizations at our meetings.
<u>Purple Bucket:</u>	The Purple Bucket for this month is for <i>Grand Strand Down Syndrome Society.</i> Their mission is to make life better for people in the community who have Down syndrome including their families and caregivers. They offer support and information to families and professionals who will promote a positive image of Down Syndrome. They bring to light the potential and greatness of each person with this disease. One of the ways they accomplish this is to start nurturing parents of babies with Downs, and provide all people, whose lives have been touched by this condition to feel welcomed and accepted. They create an atmosphere for individuals to network, socialize, and become better informed. When able, they support local, state, and national efforts to ensure fair and equitable conditions for all people who have Down syndrome.
